<u>Defense</u>

Bidding and the Play of the Hand are important, but bridge players are defenders more often than declarers. Want some strategies to tell your partner to switch of a new suit, or "legally" tell your partner what suit to lead next? We will spend five weeks on leads, attitude and suit preference aspects of defense. <u>Prerequisite</u>: basic knowledge of bidding and the play of the hand.
